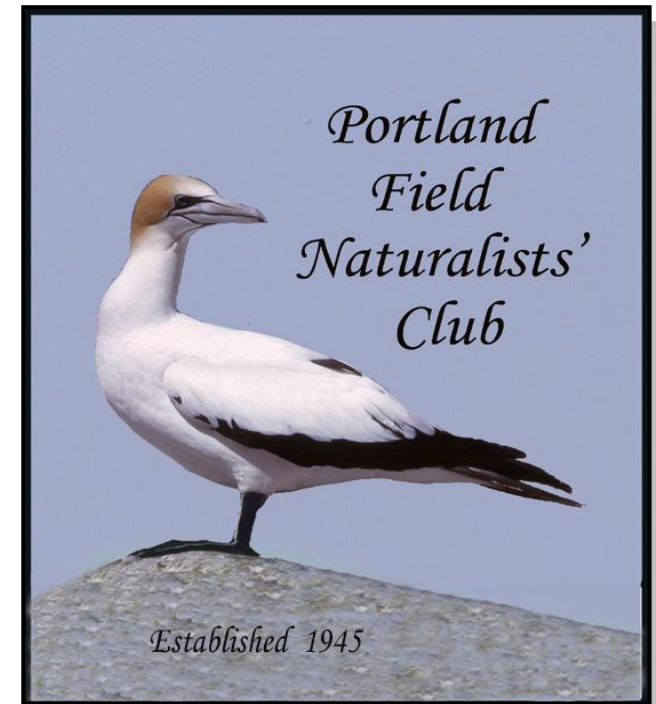
CLUB ACHIEVEMENTS
